# WHAT'S THE SFSC EXPO ABOUT?

#### In 2024, the Short Food Supply Chain Expo

is organized for the third time, by the founder, Kislépték Association. This year, the National Agricultural Chamber and the Hungarian National Rural Network has also decided to partner up with us, in order to organize the event.

The first and second Expositions presented numerous innovative payment, logistics, packaging machinery producing companies, local producers' groups and supporting organizations, to create a forum on local production, and opportunities for market access. The importance is prevelant in the fact that the first event gathered 40 exhibitors and 200 visitors, while in 2022 this augmented to 50 exhibitors and 300 visitors!

We welcome companies and enterprises as exhibitors, who are connected to the short food supply chain (SFSC) by producing production, feeding, processing, packaging, banking, billing, IT, logistical tools, offer such services or financial opportunities. Our target audience are the professionals of the field, short food supply chain organizers, advisors, rural developers, and those interested in subsidies (e.g. minicipalities), domestic small-scale producers, family farms.

In 2024 the focus is on the cooperation opportunities lying in supply chains, and this year's highlighted products are **honey, honey-based products and the grains' value chain.** 

The presentation of domestic honey and information on their roles has a huge importance in informing the consumers, which encourages quality honey production and supports the increase of domestic honey consumption - both quality and quantity-wise.

To combat the 2023 grain market anomalies we are creating a separate section for **small-scale grain processing and sales solutions in the exhibition.** During the Expo, many small mills, the **"farmermiller-baker network"**, the new and traditional ways of processing and selling grains will all be introducing themselves.

We will also touch on the **60/2023 order of the agricultural minister concerning the hygiene requirements for small-scale, local and marginalized food production and sales,** published november 15th 2023, which contains the current regulations for small-scale producers, and which offers new possibilities for small-scale processing and easier market access.

The SFSC EXPO in reaction to today's challenges is focusing on the quality, traditional-tasting, innovative food produced by Hungarian producers, namely domestic product offer that can satiate the current consumers' expectations.

Based on the above-mentioned challenges and opportunities we would like to offer good practices and patterns for SFSC actors (producers, market organizers, rural developers, basket communities, suppliers, consultants, restaurants and merchants selling local products, municipalities, LEADER organizations, gardeners) in the framework of this country-wide and international event.
